Antigua to St Vincent

7 Days

DAY 1 | Depart from Antigua and sail to Guadeloupe (42 miles)

Guadeloupe is one of the Caribbean's more developed islands; whilst here, enjoy dinner at one of the many excellent restaurants or head to one of the beautiful, secluded white beaches for some windsurfing.

DAY 2 | Depart Guadeloupe and sail to Iles des Saintes (20 miles)

Something of a hidden treasure, these idyllic islands are home to the picture-postcard town of Le Bourg; with a couple of hours on-shore, you can snorkel in the bay or hire a scooter and explore the mainland.

DAY 3 | Depart Iles des Saintes and sail to Dominica (20 miles)

There is plenty to see and do in Dominica, including diving and whale-watching; take a tour of the Indian River for an insight into the island's unique mini eco-system or head to the 'boiling' lake – a huge thermal spring, situated in Morne Trois Pitons National Park.

DAY 4 | Depart Dominica and sail to Martinique (40 miles)

Like Guadeloupe, Martinique is an overseas region of France – with the addition of its very own Creole culture. An excellent selection of bars, restaurants and shops combine with some of the Caribbean's most wonderful scenery, including a smouldering volcano and some stunning coral reefs, offering plenty for visitors to see and do.

DAY 5 | Depart Martinique and sail to Marigot Bay, St Lucia (40 miles)

Once a favourite haunt of pirates, St Lucia has been host to visitors for over three centuries. Marigot Marina, with its lively local restaurants and bars, is also one of the Caribbean's most exclusive yachting destinations.

DAY 6 | Depart Marigot Bay and sail to The Pitons, St Lucia (15 miles)

The most photographed landmark in St Lucia, the two towering dormant volcanoes – Gros Piton and Petit Piton – dominate the landscape. Head to the town of Soufriere, nestled beneath Petit Piton, and the drive-through Soufriere Volcano – so-named because of the road running through the centre of this, still active, volcano.

DAY 7 | Depart The Pitons and sail to St Vincent (25 miles)

Allow this enchanting island to cast its spell over you and persuade you to anchor up for a lot longer than you had planned; there are tropical gardens to visit and bird-watching, cricket matches and scuba-diving (on pristine reefs) to enjoy, as well as the lively town of Kingstown to visit; a throwback to colonial times, complete with cobbled streets and locals rushing about – scenes reminiscent of those in the film, 'Pirates of the Caribbean'.
